## Message from Rev. Ben Sear

June 2021



How are you? How are you feeling about lockdown restrictions coming to an end? I suspect we all feel different about it. For some of us it will bring great joy, for others of us it may bring nervousness, for others it may, perhaps for the first time, bring a sense of realisation of what we have been through, even fresh grief.

I admit that recently, as there has been talk of an end to the restrictions, I've been feeling that sense of having been through something difficult. There are conflicted feelings within. There is the joy at the thought of things returning but also that sense of grief. I think feeling more than one emotion like that, is perfectly natural.

As a church we want to mark the end of lockdown restrictions, first with a sense of celebration and are planning an event we hope to let you know about soon.

However, we also want to acknowledge the pain and struggle that the pandemic has brought. Some of us may have lost much and we want to provide an opportunity to acknowledge this. Later in the year we are planning to hold a service of thanksgiving and remembrance, which will be an opportunity to acknowledge what we have been through together and remember, grieve, and give thanks for the lives of those we have may lost this past year or so. More details on this will follow in due course.

In this world of difficulty, Christians live both in a state of hope and mourning. There is always hope, but we are not immune to the pain of this broken world. Jesus, God himself, demonstrated this combination of hope and grief. When Jesus arrived at the tomb of his friend Lazarus, we find the shortest verse in Bible, which tells us that "Jesus wept" (John 11:35). He knew that his friend Lazarus was about to be raised to life, a vivid demonstration of Jesus' authority over life and death. Yet, he cried, because feeling pain in the wake of suffering and death is perfectly legitimate.

To follow Jesus is to follow a saviour who knows what it means to grieve and a saviour we can talk to about our sufferings. But it also to know a saviour who offers hope. At Lazarus' tomb, Jesus also said "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die." In his own resurrection, Jesus would show us that this is not an empty promise, but words that have been vindicated, words worthy of believing.

I hope to see you soon.

County Council Election result for the Buxted and Maresfield Division is: \_

Ian Tysh	Green	670

The Division, i.e. County electoral area, includes Buxted, Five Ash Down, Maresfield, Fairwarp, High Hurstwood, Isfield, Piltdown, Fletching, Nutley, Danehill, Chelwood Gate and parts of Forest Row.

The East Sussex Election result was (2017 results in brackets) :

Conservatives	27 (30)
Liberal Democrat	11(11)
Labour	5 (4)
Green	4 ( 0 )
Independent	3 ( 5 )

The main issues of concern raised by voters were the level of house building in our area and the state of our roads.

This has been well and truly noted by me and other councillors of all persuasions. There is a lively debate and there will be action.

County and District Councils are concentrating on the recovery of local businesses and retail on the High Street. Government financial support is still available and Wealden Council staff are helping firms to open safely.

**Annual Parish Assembly:** This was again cancelled this year and as in 2020 all households have been sent a copy of the Parish Annual Report

**Maresfield Recreation Ground Pavilion:** The refurbished pavilion is available for hire for meetings and appropriate events. Please contact the Parish Clerk on 714555.

**Junction of Nursery Lane with the A22 in Nutley:** A Petition was raised and has been presented to the Leader of the County Council to try and get some action to find a solution to this road safety hazard.

**Maresfield in Bloom:** A fun event for the whole Village is being arranged on the Recreation Ground for Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> June. VIPs will be attending and some presentations will also be made (including the Margory Pegg Awards). All parishioners welcome – look out for further details.

**Parking in our Villages:** There are no public car parks in any of our three villages and the privacy of the private car parks needs to be respected. And whilst there are no general parking restrictions on our roads, parking should be safe, not obstructive and respect residents accesses.

**Dog Poo:** This is still a problem in the Parish, especially on our recreation grounds and public footpaths. We appeal to all dog owners to pick it up and take it home or put it in the bins where provided.

**Highways Issues:** We are resuming our periodic meetings with East Sussex Highways in June. Please let the Parish Clerk know of any particular road safety or other highways issues we should raise.

**New Councillors:** We recently welcomed newly co-opted members, Rob Hunter and John Lewis, to the Parish Council but still have vacancies for three more councillors. Please consider volunteering for this worthwhile community service. Contact the Clerk for further information.

**Parish Council Meetings:** The legislation enabling us to hold formal Council and Committee meetings remotely has expired and has not been renewed. We will therefore have to resume in person meetings in June but will ensure that all necessary social distancing and other measures are in place so that Councillors and members of the public can attend in safety.

The Climate Change Interest Group is made up of local people and our aim is to challenge Maresfield Parish residents to make changes in a variety of areas for the good of the environment. We hope you feel inspired to join in with some of our suggestions and would welcome your feedback.

**June 2021 – Reduce, Reuse, Recycle – Do we do enough?**

Most of us try to recycle and reuse to reduce waste but are there ways we can improve how we do this and should we reconsider what we recycle?

**Reduce** Is favourite for the climate, from fashion to food today's easy come, easy go, throw away mentality is very harmful for the environment. Lets all take a minute to consider if we really need that next purchase and what will we do with the item its replacing.

**Reuse** Could that item be repaired? there are local Repair Cafes that may be able to help or could someone else make use of it, there are several neighbourhood sites, such as freecycle, where you can advertise unwanted items and nearly always it will be useful to someone and of course we have many charity shops always in need of donations.

**Recycle** It takes 75% less energy to make a plastic bottle from recycled plastic, compared with using 'virgin' materials, and recycling just one plastic bottle conserves enough energy to light a 60 watt light bulb for up to 6 hours.

Harmful chemicals and greenhouse gases are released from the incineration of landfill rubbish, that which is not recycled, so the more we can recycle the less rubbish has to be incinerated.

Trees take CO<sub>2</sub> out of the atmosphere and replace it with oxygen. Recycling just a 3 foot stack of newspapers saves one tree.

Lets take a look at what we buy and how it is packaged. For instance if we invest in re-usable mesh bags for our vegetables when we shop, not only are we saving money as loose produce is cheaper but we are saving on all of the unnecessary packaging.

By purchasing re-usable pot lids and wraps we can cut down on the use of clingfilm.

Often items we don't believe are recyclable can be if we look a little deeper. Did you know that Green DIY in Uckfield recycle a range of items that your kerbside bin wont take such as crisp packets and bread bags, its amazing how many of these an average family can accumulate.

As well as our kerbside recycling bins we have a very comprehensive household recycling facility in Maresfield, its well worth visiting their website to familiarise yourself with all of the things they will recycle.

Next time we are about to put something in the general waste bin lets just stop and take a minute to think if there is something else we can do with it that would be better for the environment.





## Fords Green June 2021

Hello everybody, at last we can see the first major event of the year (actually about 2 years!) when the Village Day happens on 26<sup>th</sup> June. As mentioned in the May update, our Clubs will be holding events during the summer, and no doubt other village organisations are making their plans.

We held our planned, limited committee meeting with the maximum of 6 permitted, in sunshine. This was between the snow in March and the almost continual frost of April! Matters discussed included the finances, subscriptions for the Clubs in the last disrupted year, plans for the coming remainder of the year, and then an extended discussion of the state of the Green playing surfaces.

Regarding the finances, I'm glad to report that we are solvent owing to reserves and generous donations from a variety of sources which included individual Nutley residents and Maresfield Parish Council. We still maintain our fund for the refurb and extension of the Pavilion which unsurprisingly has been on hold in recent months. Regarding Club subs, we believe an equitable method has been reached and this will further boost the resources. Events for later in the year will mainly encompass cricket, stoolball and their families for matches with teas, raffles and general fun on the Green. I'm sure there will be others also.

As previously mentioned, the Green and others in the village have been suffering from the chafer bugs. An investigation, instigated by the Football Club, researched the reasons and the cure and grants are being sought. A special multi-tool Quadraplay has been ordered, to be paid for by an agreed grant and the Football Club, and the assessment of the ground and resulting grant from the Football Foundation is in the pipeline. The Football Club is taking the lead in raising the money starting with a Crowdfunder page [www.crowdfunder.co.uk/sport-on-the-green](http://www.crowdfunder.co.uk/sport-on-the-green) and your generous support will be much appreciated. A further grant has been made by Maresfield Parish council and the Fords Green Committee will pick up the balance. The condition of the ground really goes to the heart of the existence of Fords Green and we have a duty to maintain it in good condition.

We expect to have a new committee following the planned AGM in June. Which gives me the opportunity to tell you that I shall not be standing again as Chair of this committee. After 6 years and my move to Forest Row, I feel that more local commitment will be better placed to carry Fords Green forward. I've been enormously grateful for the support from the Committee members and all in the village, and have been glad to be associated with the much loved village Green.


